BEHAVIOR

Always travel with more than one person. Never should you be alone.

Always be on time. If you are late to a show, you will not get in, and you will be considered truant with all of the disciplinary actions that follow.

Do not put feet on the seats or step over the seats to get to a different row. Be very quiet during the show. No cell phones, no gum, no crinkly wrappers, etc.

No drugs, no alcohol, no theft, no foul talk (foul breath optional).

You must remain chaste for the duration on the trip.

There will be a curfew, and it will be enforced.

No boys in the girls' rooms and vice-versa.

You must enjoy yourself, make friends, and learn a ton about theater and about life.
