<u>Please note</u>: Students must do the following before going:

- 1. They must be a Drama Club member to go on this trip. The Drama Boosters have defrayed the cost by \$2500. This money is meant to "boost" the Drama Club. They may become members by paying \$10 to the book keepers.
- 2. They must sign up on FamilyID and check the box, "Drama Travel".
- 3. They must pay \$275 by September 7 to the book keepers. Checks may be written out to RSD.
- 4. Not be failing any classes
- 5. Come to ALL the pre-trip meetings.
